FTML COURSE

Fundamentals of Transitional Ministry: The Work of the Leader, is a three-day course designed to upskill and equip ministers and those in lay ministry with the skills to support congregations in times of transition or change as a community.

Overview

Fundamentals of Transitional Ministry: The Work of the Leader is a three-day program which gives participants an introduction to the key concepts and practices of ministering with congregations and agencies in times of transition.

The course has three key foundations:

- Understanding Transition
- Systems Theory
- Family Systems

These key foundations are introduced on Day 1 and then unpacked by reflecting on transitions that lead to new life and ministry practice. The course also teaches an array of tools for understanding one's ministry context, and one's place within it.

While it is a stand-alone program, it can also be the first phase of training that leads to being qualified as an Intentional Interim Minister.

FTML is useful for anyone in lay or ordained ministry, who are dealing with change, transition and new opportunities and also for those exploring a call to Intentional Interim Ministry.

- People in lay ministry
- People in ordained ministerial roles
- On a pathway to ministry
- Presbytery Staff & Office bearers
- Third phase of ministry participants

FTML will be led by Rob McFarlane, a Presbytery Ministry Leader from the Parramatta Nepean Presbytery, and recognised as a trainer by the Interim Ministry Network.

The history of the course

Intentional Interim Ministry (IIM) began in a formal way in the USA in 1980 with the inauguration of the Interim Ministry Network (IMN). The IMN is a cooperative venture between several denominations to help churches and organisations undergoing major transitions to benefit from the short term ministry or leadership of an interim specialist.

Rather than one major single course of training for IIM, an introductory course “Fundamentals of Transitional Ministry” is now available for all leaders, followed by a longer program for people who satisfy entry requirements to train as IIM specialists.

Some individuals will recognise the term IIM and this FTML is a directly linked program endorsed and based in IIM education.
