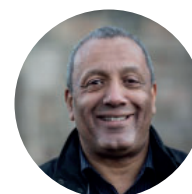

Prof. John Swinton



John Swinton is Professor of Practical Theology at the University of Aberdeen and founder of the university's Centre for Spirituality, Health and Disability. He is a global leader in the area of disability theology and has published a number of books, including *Living Gently in a Violent World: The Prophetic Witness of Weakness* (with Jean Vanier and Stanley Hauerwas, 2008), *Dementia: Living in the Memories of God* (2012), and *Becoming Friends of Time: Disability, Timefulness, and Gentle Discipleship* (2016)
